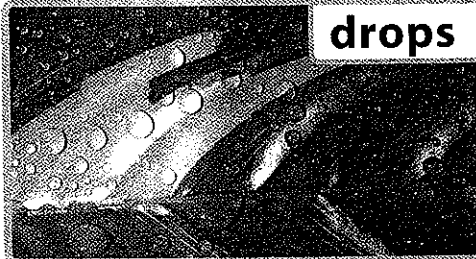
Use the picture and sentence to learn each word.

Sam enjoyed looking at the **pale** yellow flowers.

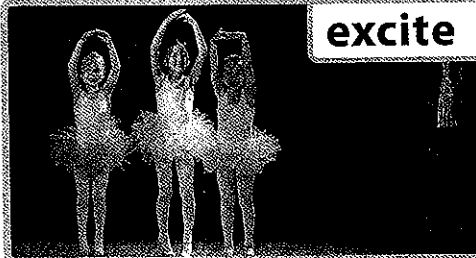
What is the opposite of pale?

Poetry Words

alliteration

I like to read a poem with **alliteration** because I like to say the same beginning sound in words.

repetition

free verse

In **free verse**, the words do not need to rhyme.
